Call for Papers

The 12th annual ILAIS (Israel Association for Information Systems) conference will be held on **June 18**, **2018** at Sami Shamoon College of Engineering, Ashdod. The Program Committee invites faculty members, research students, final-year undergraduate students and industry researchers in the IS field to submit an **extended abstract** for the following tracks:

Completed Research Paper (Conference Presentation)

Extended 3-page (maximum, excluding references) abstract for a completed research paper should include: title, author(s), introduction, objectives, method, results, and conclusions. The structure of theoretical/conceptual/practical papers can be adjusted as needed.

Research-in-Progress Paper (Conference Presentation)

Extended 2-page (maximum, excluding references) abstract for a research-in-progress paper should include: title, author(s), introduction, objectives, method, initial results (if available), and initial conclusions (if available). The structure of theoretical/conceptual/practical papers can be adjusted as needed.

Please note: Authors for the completed Research and Research-in-Progress tracks retain all copyrights and will be asked to agree to publish their abstracts online as conference proceedings. This arrangement allows publishing the complete version elsewhere (including journals, conferences and books).

Early Stage Thesis or Student Project (Poster)

ILAIS 2018 provides an opportunity for students to exhibit projects or theses at an early stage as a poster. An extended 1-page (maximum, excluding references) abstract for a completed student project or early stage thesis should include: title, student(s) and advisor(s) names, introduction, objectives, method, initial results (if available), and initial conclusions (if available). The structure of theoretical/conceptual/practical thesis or project can be adjusted as needed. Details regarding poster preparation will be provided later on.

Although all topics within the IS research domain are welcome, this year we are especially interested in **Human-Computer Interaction (HCI)** research, **ICT** (Information and Communication Technologies), **Socio-Technical** design, **Cyber Security**, **IS Education** and **Data Analytics** using advanced **Data Mining** and **Machine Learning** methods. Additionally, in order to broaden the ILAIS audience, researchers in domains intersecting **Software Engineering** and **Information Systems** are more than welcome to participate.
