The 15th annual ILAIS conference will be held on July 6, 2021 at The Open University of Israel. ILAIS 2021 will be either a fully online virtual event or a hybrid event, enabling onsite as well as virtual participation. The Program Committee invites faculty members, research students, and industry researchers in the IS field to submit:

- **Completed Research** (1,200-2,500 words, 20 minutes for presentation and discussion). Each submission should include: introduction, theory, method, results, implications and conclusions. <u>Link to the template</u>
- Research-in-Progress (800-1,200 words, 10 minutes for presentation and discussion). Each submission should include: introduction, theory, method, results (if available), implications and conclusions (if available). <u>Template</u>
- Recently Published Research. Forthcoming or recently published (2020-2021) IS research (10 minutes for presentation and discussion). Please send the full paper for consideration. Only the title and a DOI link will be published.

To enable international participation, the language of the conference is English.
